Position Description:

The Chief Mission Operations Candidate is part of the greater Systems Engineering Integration and Test team at SAGE Black. Performs technical planning, system integration, verification and validation, cost and risk, and support ability and effectiveness analyses for total systems. Analyses are performed at all levels of total system product to include: concept, design, fabrication, test, installation, operation, maintenance and disposal. Ensures the logical and systematic conversion of customer or product requirements into total systems solutions that acknowledge technical, schedule, and cost constraints. Performs functional analysis, timeline analysis, detailed trade studies, requirements allocation and interface definition studies to translate customer requirements into hardware and software specifications. Generate CONOP for new capabilities. Coordinate with product owners and SE/CMO team and users to determine best implementation approach to meet the mission goals. Coordinate with users to determine root cause of operational issues and support development and test teams in resolving those issues. Provide operational readiness checkout of the new baseline prior to delivery. This role is a user advocate and can express user needs and issues to the program. Perform site transition, to train the user on the system, transition new users to the system and then provide sustained support to those users as they become familiar with the baseline. Perform remote training sessions to inform users of new capabilities and give refresher training remotely.
